

CONTINUING CARE BURSARY PROGRAM (CCBP)

Continuing Care facilities are experiencing ongoing human resource supply challenges, particularly in the delivery of personal care services by Continuing Care Assistants (CCA). To help long-term and home care agencies to recruit and retain CCA graduates, the Department of Health has developed the *Continuing Care Bursary Program (CCBP)*.

The various agencies identified below participate in the *CCBP* and may be interested in sponsoring students accepted into a Continuing Care Program at the Nova Scotia Community College (NSCC). Following an interview process, a Home may decide to sponsor a student with up to 70% of tuition costs. You will be required to sign a Return of Service Agreement.

If you are interested in applying for bursary assistance, please call one of the agencies below to **arrange an appointment time once you have been accepted into the program and prior to the start date of your program**. We look forward to hearing from you to discuss sponsorship opportunities.
